













Why did Adolf Hitler consider the Slavic people to be "sub human"?

Most western Europeans had a mild to severe disdain for Slavic people, as they were often viewed as backwards backwater simpletons; comparatively to how Americans seem to typically view the "Rednecks". However, there is little evidence to prove that Slavic people were considered "subhumans" even with the stereotypes present, as the third reich employed many Slavs into it's ranks (See: SS RONA, ROA [Russian liberation army], Ukrainian SS, Bulgarian SS, Croatian SS Hanschar, Yugoslav SS, Serbian SDK, even the Polish SS Heimwehr unit [the list goes on and on, even Indians were in the wehrmacht. See: Free Indian legion].

The conceptualization of Eastern Europeans being non-Aryan and subhumans has been challenged by two historians:

"What is for the Third Reich itself, that, contrary to modern popular belief, no frantic focused russophobia there was not. The prevailing ignorance of most of the biological history of the Russian people, and most importantly - sustainable reluctance to get to know her ". The fact of recognition and in Germany during the Third Reich, a book like "Racology ancient Slavs", helps break down many of the stereotypes of the Soviet and post-Soviet and a liberal eras, like the Germans, intoxicated by their own propaganda of racial superiority, looked at people living in the neighboring eastern area as "subhuman". This is certainly an illiterate fantasy biased journalists never held in the hands of authentic German primary sources of the time "

Why do so many people repeat this myth? Slavs were not considered to be untermenschen or anything of the kind, many National Socialists even had Slavic ancestry, the Nuremberg race laws did not forbid any sexual relations between Germans and Slavs (during the war all sexual relations between foreigners was forbid though).

Himmler said "Untermenschenvolk des Ostens" = "subhuman people of the East" in the brochure Treatment of Peoples of Alien Races in the East but he was talking about the Judeo Bolsheviks, not Slavs.

The National Socialists never used the word Untermenschen to describe Slavs.
